Dear City of Medina:

The State of Ohio, Department of Transportation is constructing a road project that consists of widening and reconstructing 2.13 miles of S.R. 18 from just West of Alber Drive in the City of Medina to the intersection of Nettleton Road in Medina and Montville Townships, Medina County. A 10' multi-use path will be constructed on the south side of S.R. 18 from Woodland Drive to Nettleton Road. Additionally, a new structure over the West Branch Rocky River will be constructed for the Multi-use path. New storm drainage and traffic signals will also be installed.

The road widening project may place affected property owners, through no fault of their own, in a non-compliance situation with respect to the City of Medina Zoning Resolution. It is anticipated that these legal non-confirming uses may involve zoning requirements relating to landscaped area between the right of way and the developed portion of the site, the minimum number of parking spaces, parking area set back, signage and fencing setback from the right of way, and the use of temporary lighting during construction. It would unfairly burden property owners, if they were required to seek variances or to incur extraordinary expenses to restore full compliance.

In similar situations, local governments benefiting from a highway improvement project have passed resolutions waiving enforcement of zoning violations directly caused by the acquisition/appropriation of additional right of way to construct the project. In short, these changes are deemed to be legal non-conforming uses, or "grandfathered".

We are currently finalizing our contracts with the Consultants who will be determining the Fair Market Value and then acquiring the needed property and improvements for this project. We expect these consultants to be ready to move into the appraisal phase with one month. The issue of zoning will have an important impact on some of these properties. ODOT representatives and the affected property owners will greatly appreciate your efforts to present this issue to the City of Medina for its immediate consideration and passage. I am providing an example of a resolution which was previously prepared for Medina Township for the road improvement on S.R. 42. My office can prepare one for City of Medina at your request. Please let me know if the City requires any further information from ODOT's representatives.

**Relating to a Moratorium on Enforcement of
Zoning Setback, Parking, and Landscape Requirements
Where Nonconformities Result from Governmental Taking of Property**

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Department of Transportation is constructing a project to widen U.S. Route 42 (Pearl Road) from the southern border of Medina Township to north of County Road 70 (Fenn Road), as well as the widening of both approaches of Fenn Road within Medina Township (the "Project"), which involves acquisition of additional right-of-way along both U.S. Route 42 and County Road 70 ("governmental action") for the Project, and

WHEREAS, this governmental action *may* affect a particular property owner's compliance with requirements relating to the landscaped area between the right-of-way and the developed portion of the site, the minimum number of parking spaces, parking area setback, signage and fencing setback from the right-of-way, and the use of temporary lighting during construction, as set forth in the Medina Township Zoning Resolution ("Zoning Resolution"), and

WHEREAS, this governmental action *may* place property owners along U.S. Route 42 and County Road 70, through no fault of their own, in a non-compliance situation with respect to the Zoning Resolution, which the Board of Township Trustees feels would unfairly burden affected property owners, if required to restore their properties to full zoning compliance, and

WHEREAS, the residents and businesses of Medina Township, as well as the traveling public, will greatly benefit from the State of Ohio Department of Transportation's improvements to U.S. Route 42 (Pearl Road) from the southern border of Medina Township to north of County Road 70 (Fenn Road), as well as the widening of both approaches of Fenn Road,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEDINA TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES THAT:

Section 1. This Board declares a moratorium upon enforcement of zoning requirements relating to the landscape area between the right-of-way and the developed portion of the site, the minimum number of parking spaces, parking area setback, signage and fencing setback from the right-of-way, and the use of temporary lighting during construction along U.S. Route 42 and County Road 70 for properties affected by the State of Ohio Department of Transportation's Project.

Section 2. It is the finding of this Board that any property owners along U.S. Route 42 and County Road 70 adversely affected by the acquisition of additional right-of-way by the State of Ohio should not be unfairly burdened with the additional expense of correcting zoning violations created by this governmental action.


Section 3. Pursuant to this moratorium, properties adversely affected by the State of Ohio's acquisition of additional right-of-way for this project shall be deemed legal nonconforming properties under the Zoning Resolution.

Section 4. The Board reserves the right in the event that it finds there is a genuine risk to the traveling public as result of any sign, fence or other improvement being too close to the right-of-way to work with the property owner to resolve the issue and to enforce the setback requirements of the Zoning Resolution after all other reasonable options have been exhausted.

Section 5. This resolution shall not be deemed to constitute an amendment to the zoning resolution or a waiver of the zoning resolution requirements except as to the issues directly arising from the acquisition of additional right-of-way in the Project area.

Section 6. The Board hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Board, and that all deliberations of the Board, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.



The Medina County SPCA is the official humane society for Medina County. As such, we:


- Investigate and prosecute animal neglect and cruelty

The majority of our funding comes from individual donations, memberships, fundraising, and adoption fees. Therefore, we do rely on the financial support of local communities to share in the expenditures we incur serving each of them. Per the request of several jurisdictions, we have changed the statistical reporting period to assist in their budgeting process.





SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND:

Over the last several months, it has come to our attention that park users are walking and running dogs off leash in City parks. Ordinance 945.02 (g) as it is worded, allows off leash dogs in City parks as long as they are under reasonable control of a person. This does not align with Ordinance 505.01 (Dogs and other animals running at large) and poses an increased risk to other park users. The Parks Department respectfully request Council to amend Ordinance 945.02 (g) as follows:

(g) ~~Permit a dog to go unleashed in any areas, without being under the reasonable control of a person.~~

(g) No person shall have a dog in a city park unless the dog is restrained by a leash that is not more than eight (8) feet in length and held by the person having the dog in the park or the dog is inside the fence of the Memorial Dog Park.

945.02 PARK RESTRICTIONS.

No person shall do any of the following in or on park or recreation lands owned or leased to the City:

- (a) Operate a motor vehicle, motorcycle, moped or any other vehicle or conveyance or ride horseback on any park land other than parking lots or other designated areas.
- (b) Possess or have under one's control, any intoxicating liquor, beer, malt liquor or wine or consume the same.
- (c) Have a fire, except in designated areas and/or containers, without prior written permission of the permitted activity by the Fire Chief and Parks and Recreation Director.
- (d) Camp, without prior written permission of the permitted activity by the Parks and Recreation Director.
- (e) Sell any goods, wares or merchandise, except sales by local service clubs, schools, religious or other charitable organizations, without prior written permission of the permitted activity by the Parks and Recreation Director.
- (f) Litter.
- (g) Permit a dog to go unleashed in any areas, without being under the reasonable control of a person.

(Ord. 210-98. Passed 11-9-98; Ord. 64-02. Passed 4-22-02.)

505.01 DOGS AND OTHER ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE.

(a) No person being the owner or having charge of cattle, sheep, geese, ducks, turkeys, chickens or other fowl or animals shall permit them to run at large upon any public place, or upon any unenclosed lands, or upon the premises of another.

(b) No person being the owner of or having charge of any dog, whether wearing a registration tag or not, shall permit it to run at large upon any public place or upon the premises of another. No owner, keeper or harbinger of any female dog shall permit such dog to go beyond the premises of such owner or keeper at any time such dog is in heat, unless such dog is properly in leash. The owner or keeper of every dog shall at all times keep such dog either confined upon the premises of the owner or keeper, or under reasonable control of some person. (ORC 955.22)

(c) The running at large of any such animal in or upon any of the places mentioned in this section is prima-facie evidence that it is running at large in violation of this section. (ORC 951.02)

(d) No owner or keeper of a dog shall permit such dog to leave the premises of the owner or keeper, except on a leash, in a suitable conveyance or container and under the control of a responsible person. (Ord. 48-64. Passed 4-27-64.)

(e) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. (ORC 955.99(A))

DOG LEASH ORDINANCE AND RULE EXAMPLES

MEDINA COUNTY PARK DISTRICT:

12.0 PETS AND DOMESTIC/WILD ANIMALS, LEASHES

- 12.1 DOGS, CATS, ANIMALS RESTRICTIONS - No person shall have or keep in a park any dog, cat, pet, or other animal destructive to birds, wildlife, or property. Dogs and cats are permitted if controlled at ALL times on a leash not more than eight (8) feet long. All pets are strictly prohibited in wildlife areas.
- 12.2 ABANDONING ANIMALS - No person shall leave behind or otherwise abandon ANY domestic, wild, or exotic animal within or adjacent to any park
- 12.3 CRUELTY TO ANIMALS - No person shall mistreat, cruelly beat, mutilate, or torture any animal.
- 12.4 VICIOUS AND DANGEROUS DOGS PROHIBITED - Vicious and dangerous dogs are prohibited on park district property.

CITY OF WADSWORTH:

§ 94.08 DOGS IN PARK.

(A) No person shall have a dog in a city park unless the dog is restrained by a leash that is not more than eight feet in length and held by the person having the dog in the park or the dog is inside the fence of the Wadsworth Community Dog Park.

(B) Whoever violates division (A) of this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.
(Ord. 04-014, passed 3-16-04; Am. Ord. 15-098, passed 10-6-15)

CITY OF STOW:

- (5) No person shall take any pet, whether on a leash or otherwise, into any park area, shelter or facility, with the following exceptions:
 - A. Pets are permitted on the Bike and Hike Trail and at the campgrounds if they are controlled at all times on a leash held in hand. Leashes shall not be longer than eight feet.
 - B. Pet litter shall be picked up and properly disposed of by the pet owner.
 - C. For the purpose of taking a dog to the Silver Springs Dog Park, dogs shall be permitted in Silver Springs Park while leashed. Once inside the designated area within the dog park, a dog may be unleashed and remain so until exiting the dog park. The Director of Parks and Recreation is hereby authorized to designate specific areas of the dog park for leashing and unleashing dogs.
 - D. Dogs 35 pounds or under will have the option of being separated from larger dogs in the park.
 - E. Any and all funding for the dog park will come from Stow Parks and Recreation's cell tower funds.
 - F. This legislation will come up for review by Council on a yearly basis to make sure that it is complied to in all aspects, at which time Council reserves the right to rescind this legislation for non-compliance.
 - G. The park will be closed any time the lake is in the freezing process or frozen.

(Ord. 2007-66. Passed 4-12-07.)

CLEVELAND METROPARKS:

Dogs and cats may accompany their owners in the Park District, however, pets must be controlled on a leash not more than eight feet long, and all excrement must be placed in a litter receptacle.

Park visitors are allowed to walk their dogs and cats on all purpose trails. Pets must be leashed, and owners must remove any animal waste.






On Sunday, January 20, 2019 approximately 0915 hours, I was advised unknown person had struck the traffic light box on the southwest corner of S. Court and Koons.


