

ORDINANCE NO. 72-14

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH WELLS FARGO INSURANCE SERVICES OF OHIO, LLC FOR THE CITY'S PROPERTY, CASUALTY, AND GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR THE PERIOD OF APRIL 1, 2014 THROUGH MARCH 31, 2015, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

- SEC. 1:** That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Wells Fargo Insurance Services of Ohio, LLC for the City's Property, Casualty and General Liability Insurance for the period of April 1, 2014 through March 31, 2015.
- SEC. 2:** That the funds to cover this expenditure are available in each appropriate budget.
- SEC. 3:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.
- SEC. 4:** That this Ordinance shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason to renew said policy which expired April 1, 2014; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
