

RESOLUTION NO. 208-14**A RESOLUTION DONATING A 2000 PIERCE PUMPER FIRE TRUCK TO THE MEDINA COUNTY CAREER CENTER FIRE TRAINING PROGRAM.**

WHEREAS: The City of Medina is the legal owner of a 2000 Pierce Pumper; and

WHEREAS: The pumper has been removed from service because of rust/corrosion issues with the frame and sub-frame, it is not road worthy, and there is no resale or trade-in value to the truck.

WHEREAS: The City believes it is in the best interest of the City to donate the 2000 Pierce Pumper to the Medina County Career Center Fire Training Program for the training and education of the students.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

SEC. 1: That Council hereby approves the donation of the 2000 Pierce Pumper, S/N 4P1CT02S5YA000978, to the Medina County Career Center Fire Training Program for the training and education of the students.

SEC. 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SEC. 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
