

RESOLUTION NO. 105-15

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF LEGAL SERVICES FROM WALKER & JOCKE CO., LPA TO FILE A TRADEMARK APPLICATION AND A COPYRIGHT APPLICATION FOR THE BICENTENNIAL LOGO FOR THE CITY OF MEDINA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: The firm Walker & Jocke Co., LPA has offered its services to the Bicentennial Committee and the City of Medina to file a Trademark Application with the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office and a Copyright Application with the Copyright Office of the Library of Congress for the new logo for the upcoming 2018 Bicentennial Celebration of the City of Medina at no cost to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

SEC. 1: That the City hereby accepts the gracious donation of legal services from Walker & Jocke Co., LPA to file a Trademark Application and a Copyright Application for the new Bicentennial Logo for the City of Medina.

SEC. 2: That the fees that Walker & Jocke Co., LPA agree to pay include the following: \$325.00 for the initial filing with the Trademark Office, \$150.00 to file the Statement of Use, and \$55.00 to the Library of Congress for the Copyright Application.

SEC. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SEC. 4: That this Resolution shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason to start the process as soon as possible so the City may begin to use the logo; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
