

ORDINANCE NO. 130-15

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 127-08, PASSED JUNE 23, 2008, RELATIVE TO THE JOB CREATION GRANT AGREEMENT FOR CARLISLE BRAKE AND FRICTION (FORMERLY FRICTION PRODUCTS COMPANY).

WHEREAS: Ordinance No. 127-08, passed June 23, 2008, authorized the Mayor to execute a Job Creation Grant Agreement for Carlisle Brake and Friction (formerly Friction Products Company); and

WHEREAS: It has been determined that Carlisle Brake and Friction has failed to fulfill its obligations under the agreement and have requested termination of the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

SEC. 1: That Ordinance No. 127-08, passed June 23, 2008, is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SEC. 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
