

ORDINANCE NO. 133-15

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO COMMENCE A QUALIFICATION BASED SELECTION (QBS) PROCESS TO SELECT A DESIGN CONSULTANT FOR THE GUILFORD BOULEVARD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT.

WHEREAS: On February 23, 2015 Council passed Resolution #30-15 authorizing the filing of an application to the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) for grant assistance for the replacement of the Guilford Boulevard Twin Culverts through their Municipal Bridge Program; and

WHEREAS: In July of this year we were notified by ODOT that our application had been approved and ODOT would be providing funding for 95% of the eligible costs (up to \$605,340) for this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

SEC. 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to commence a Qualification Based Selection (QBS) process to select a Design Consultant for the Guilford Boulevard Bridge Replacement Project.

SEC. 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SEC. 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
