ORDINANCE NO. 78-16

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE NOT TO EXCEED \$90,000.00 TO ACCESS INFORMATION MANAGEMENT FOR THE SCANNING AND INDEXING OF CLOSED COURT CASES AT THE MEDINA MUNICIPAL COURT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: This Ordinance will provide for the efficient and lawful certifications to provide Municipal Services; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

- **SEC. 1:** That in accordance with Ohio Revised Code §5705.41(D), at the time that the contract or order was made and at the time of execution of the Finance Director's certificate, sufficient funds were available or in the process of collection, to the credit of a proper fund, properly appropriated and free from any previous encumbrance.
- SEC. 2: That the expenditure of not to exceed \$90,000.00 is hereby authorized to ACCESS Information Management for the scanning and indexing of closed court cases at the Medina Municipal Court.
- **SEC. 3:** That the funds to cover this expenditure are available in Account No. 001-0710-52215.
- SEC. 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.
- SEC. 5: That this Ordinance shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
