

ORDINANCE NO. 111-16

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO AUTHORIZE THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) TO ACCEPT ADD ALTERNATE #1 PERTAINING TO DECORATIVE LIGHTING FOR THE US 42 CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

SEC. 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to authorize the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) to accept Add Alternate #1 pertaining to decorative lighting for the US 42 Corridor Improvement Project, PID #92954.

SEC. 2: That the funds to cover this add alternate, in the amount of \$127,900.00, are available in Account No. 108-0610-54414.

SEC. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SEC. 3: That this Ordinance shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason the deadline to inform ODOT of this alternate is August 10, 2016; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
