

ORDINANCE NO. 144-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 111-16, PASSED AUGUST 2, 2016, RELATIVE TO ADD ALTERNATE #1 PERTAINING TO DECORATIVE LIGHTING FOR THE US 42 CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: Ordinance No. 111-16, passed August 2, 2016, authorized Add Alternate #1 pertaining to decorative lighting for the US 42 Corridor Improvement Project, PID #92954; and

WHEREAS: ODOT advised that the total amount due that they provided for us previously did not include the construction engineering costs associated with the street lights, and they request that the City increase the contract amount authorized from \$127,900.00 to \$136,850.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

SEC. 1: That the contract amount authorized in Ordinance No. 111-16, passed August 2, 2016, is hereby amended from \$127,900.00 to \$136,850.00 for Add Alternate #1 pertaining to decorative lighting for the US 42 Corridor Improvement Project, PID #92954.

SEC. 2: That the funds to cover these change orders are available as Account No. 108-0610-54414.

SEC. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SEC. 4: That this Ordinance shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that payment is due by October 14, 2016; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
