

ORDINANCE NO. 148-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 142-18, PASSED SEPTEMBER 24, 2018, RELATIVE TO THE EXPENDITURE TO WATCHGUARD VIDEO FOR THE PURCHASE OF A NEW BODY AND CRUISER CAMERA SYSTEM FOR THE MEDINA POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: Ordinance No. 142-18, passed September 24, 2018, authorized the expenditure of \$81,412.50 to WatchGuard Video for the purchase of a new body and cruiser camera system for the Medina Police Department; and

WHEREAS: Due to a clerical error, the amount of the expenditure was incorrect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

SEC. 1: That the amount of the expenditure authorized in Ordinance No. 142-18, passed September 24, 2018, is hereby amended from \$81,412.50 to \$95,020.00 for the purchase of a new body and cruiser camera system for the Medina Police Department.

SEC. 2: That the funds to cover this expenditure, in the full amount of \$95,020.00 are available in Account No. 106-0101-50111.

SEC. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SEC. 4: That this Ordinance shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that the current camera system is failing; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
