

PROJECT SCOPE
For
City of Medina 2018 CONCRETE PAVEMENT GENERAL SERVICES PROGRAM

General

This is an annual program that consists of the excavation, removal and replacement of concrete pavement and concrete sidewalks throughout the City. The City will use this program to complete the City's annual concrete sidewalk repair program, water breaks and miscellaneous concrete repairs and installation.

The City will submit notice to complete the City's annual sidewalk program to the contractor all at one time (not as individual locations). All other work will be assigned as needed throughout the term of the contract.

Traffic control is required.

Bid Information

The Bid includes a base bid only. The base bid includes unit price items for pavement and sidewalk removal, concrete sidewalk placement, and concrete pavement placement. All unit prices include mobilization of equipment, materials and labor to the project area. All unit prices include furnishing and installing topsoil and seeding as necessary to restore abutting areas disturbed by the work.

General Notes

The Bidders attention is directed to the project specifications which have been modified from previous year's programs'. Specifically:

- Furnishing and installation of topsoil and grass seed to restore areas abutting concrete sidewalk and/or pavement removal and replacement is to be included for the unit price bid for those items.
- The bid includes a unit price item for MOBILIZATION. The City will pay for a mobilization each time the City asks the contractor to complete work.

Special Note for Sidewalk Removal and Replacement Item:

The contractor that is awarded the sidewalk removal and replacement item will be required to honor the unit price bid for those items to any City property owner that requests this work. The awarded Contractor will invoice and collect payment from the individual City property owners that request sidewalk removal and replacement through this program.

Prevailing Wage

Prevailing Wage Rates WILL apply to this project. All labor utilized for this project for both the general contractor and any sub-contractor must be paid in strict compliance with the State of Ohio Prevailing Wage Rates. Please refer to Section 6. Prevailing Wage Rates of the Contract Documents for additional information.

Contract Term

The contract for this program will run for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of signing. The contractor is required to honor the unit prices submitted for this work throughout the length of the contract.

Bid and Award Date

Bids will be accepted until 10:30 A.M. Friday, August 24, 2018, at which time they will be opened and read publicly. The City anticipates issuing a notice to proceed no later than September 7, 2018. The City of

Medina reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bid.
