

**PROJECT SCOPE \*\*\*REVISED\*\***

For

**City of Medina Job No. 971: State Road Rail Crossing Upgrade**

(Please note, revisions to the original project scope shown in **underlined italicized bold** print.)

**General**

This Project consists of the upgrade of the railroad crossing at State Road in the City of Medina by constructing gates and flashers. In addition to the gates and flashers, there will be improvements to the rail structure east of the crossing. Specifically, 300 lineal feet of ballast will be removed a total of 30 feet wide (15 feet on each side of the rail centerline). Total removal depth will be 18 inches; new crossties (approximately 200) and new ballast (approximately 1,000 tons) will be placed in this area.

Bidders must submit their bid using the Official Bid Form. The Official Bid Form includes unit prices for all applicable improvement items. The flashing lights and gates are included as a lump sum item to furnish and install both gates.

Power service to the lights and gates will be provided by the City of Medina; all costs for providing power to this location will be the responsibility of the City of Medina. Bidders do not have to include any costs within their bid for power service.

The work and the construction to be performed under this Project shall meet the standards approved by the American Railway Engineering and Maintenance of Way and City standards.

The Contractor shall furnish steel and iron products that are made in the United States according to the applicable provisions of Federal regulations stated in 23 CFR 635.410 and State of Ohio laws, and ORC §§ 153.011 and 5525.21, and State of Ohio Department of Transportation Construction and Material Specifications, 109.09.

**Labor Rates and Payroll Reporting Requirements**

The contractor shall fully comply and pay all employees in accordance with the Federal Labor Standards Provisions. These provisions are included within these bid documents and require compensation to all employees in accordance with the prevailing wage rate of wages on Public Improvements as ascertained and determined by Davis Bacon and related Act Requirements, and made a part of this contract. A copy of said rates is on file in the office of the City Engineer for inspection by all interested parties. Please refer to the Prevailing Wage Rate Section of these specifications for additional information.

**Bid Information**

The Bid includes the following:

- For a bid to be considered for award, the following items must be submitted:
  1. Non-Collusion Affidavit (included within Section #8 of the bid documents)
  2. Bidder Information and Experience Record (included within Section #8 of the bid documents).
  3. A certified check or cashier's check, or bid bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the amount bid (supplied by the Bidder)
  4. Bid Proposal (included within Section #8 of the bid documents).

**Bid and Award Date**

Bids will be accepted until 10:00 A.M. on **Wednesday, December 16, 2015**, at which time they will be opened and read publicly. Contractors shall assume that the City will award the bid by **Monday, December 28, 2015**. The City anticipates issuing a notice to proceed no later than **Monday, January 4, 2016**. The City of Medina reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bid.

**Completion Date**

This project must be completed no later than **June 30, 2016**. Within the bid form, Contractors who so choose may submit a completion earlier than **June 30, 2016**. Bids with proposed completion dates beyond **June 30, 2016** WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR AWARD. Please note, completion date will be a factor during the review and consideration of the bids received. It is possible that a bid other than the lowest bid received may be selected due to a more favorable completion date
