Guidelines Governing the Collection of Solid Waste Materials and Yard Waste from Residential Properties

- 1. **ALL MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE**: (except excluded items) will be collected once a week at the curb. Items should be placed as close to the road as practical.
- 2. **ALL WASTE MATERIALS** shall be placed in non-disposable metal and/or plastic refuse containers or plastic bags. The non-disposable metal and/or plastic containers must have two handles and have a maximum capacity of 40 gallons and shall not exceed 35 pounds. Plastic bags must be securely tied and be of adequate thickness and not exceed thirty-five pounds. Do not use cardboard boxes or paper bags as trash containers. (Note: Spraying of ammonia or bleach on plastic bags will deter animals from scattering trash).
- 3. **FOR ROLL-OFF RENTAL** information call (330) 722-9026. Roll-off dumpsters are available to all City residents.
- 4. **GLASS** Residents are asked to place glass waste into their regular rubbish container(s) for disposal with other household waste.
- 5. **AUTOMOBILE TIRES** cannot be disposed of in landfills. Old tires must be disposed of at tire dealers, new car dealerships or participating service stations. (Call Medina County Solid Waste District for participating collection centers: 330-769-0289).
- 6. **PLAYGROUND SETS** must be cut in four feet lengths and bundled with heavy cord. Bundles shall not exceed 35lbs.

- 7. **APPLIANCES, BULK OR LARGE ITEMS** such as stoves, TV's (flat screen & projector TV's ONLY) washers, refrigerators, carpeting/padding (cut into 4 foot lengths, rolled and tied into manageable bundles, etc.) should be placed curb side with your regular collection. Mattresses and furniture may also be placed on the tree lawn for pick up. Note: Refrigerator and/or freezer doors must be removed.
- A. Refrigeration Appliances: (includes air conditioners and dehumidifiers). Federal law prohibits the disposal of FREON into landfills. Freon must be removed by a certified technician (See "Appliance Repair Business" in the Yellow Pages) who will then label the appliance indicating that the Freon material has been removed. Appliances not labeled as such, WILL NOT BE picked up by the City of Medina.

8. YARD WASTE (WHICH INCLUDES BRANCHES, HEDGE CLIPPINGS, GARDEN WASTE) will be picked up on your regular trash pick up day. Have yard waste material curbside by 6:00am.

<u>Please use only metal or plastic containers for yard waste.</u>

Yard waste may be taken to the Medina County Solid Waste Facility at no charge.

A. **Branches** should be cut in four feet lengths and bundled securely with twine or rope. Bundles shall not exceed two feet in diameter. <u>DO NOT BAG YOUR BRANCHES</u>. Please bundle or use cans.

- B. Grass Clippings will not be picked up by the City of Medina. Do not place your grass clippings in bags or cans and do not mix your grass clippings with garbage. If you feel you must bag your grass, you may take it to the Medina County Solid Waste Facility during regular operating hours (at no charge) or they can be removed by a lawn maintenance company. (See "Lawn Maintenance" in the Yellow Pages).
- C. **Leaf Collection** The Medina City Street Department is responsible for leaf collection during the fall. During leaf season, updates and leaf collection information may be obtained by calling **(330) 725-LEAF.**

In order for the leaf program to operate more efficiently, please follow the guidelines provided below:

Bagged Leaves - Collected All Year

Bagged leaves will be picked up the same day with your normal trash pickup. Bags should be securely tied and be of adequate thickness and not exceed 35 pounds. Bags should be curbside by 6:00am.

<u>Leaves Raked to Curb for Pick Up- Fall Season</u> <u>Only</u>

- Leaves should be placed on your tree lawn NEXT to the curb in a windrow. (If you do not have a tree lawn, put them as close to the city sidewalk as possible).
- DO NOT mix brush, grass or rubbish in with leaves (brush should be put out with your rubbish on your designated pick up day)
- Do not put leaves in the street
- ❖ DO NOT allow children to play in the leaves

- on or near the street.
- DO NOT park vehicles over leaves. The heat from the underside of the vehicle may cause a fire.
- DO NOT rake leaves into the street after leaves have been removed from your street or you will be subject to a FINE.

Street crews will perform the annual Curbside Leaf Collection Program beginning Mid-October. The City will be divided into two sectors; North and South. Smith Road will be the divider.

One truck dispatched in the North. One truck dispatched in the South sector and the third Leaf Vacuum truck will float between the two areas to accommodate large volumes.

- D. **Christmas Trees** will be picked up for a two week period starting on the first work day after December 25th.
- 9. **CARDBOARD & LARGE BOXES** should be collapsed and tied in bundles weighing no more that 35 pounds and not more than 4 feet in length.
- 10. WASTE OIL- Waste oil (used motor oil) cannot be disposed of with your regular trash. Used motor oil is recyclable. Several service stations will accept used motor oil in minimal quantities (five gallons or less). Call the Solid Waste District Office for a list of participating dealers (330-769-0289). The public may also bring used motor oil to the Central Processing Facility (CPF) free of charge during regular hours of operation.

11. HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

(HHW)- Items such as acids/alkaline, aerosols, antifreeze, bleach, cleaners, polishes, iodine, paint, pesticides/herbicides, gasoline, kerosene, gas, cylinders and solvents (paint thinner, turpentine, varnish, stripper) must be managed properly and safely. Call the Medina County Solid Waste District Office (330-769-0289) for information on proper management and disposal of HHW.

- 12. **NEEDLES (SHARPS)** shall be placed in a rigid container with a secured lid and clearly labeled "sharps".
- 13. **DELAYS IN COLLECTIONS** may occur occasionally due to inclement weather or official holidays. However, the Sanitation Clerk should be notified of any collections that are missed on a regular basis.
- 14. **HOLIDAYS** New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day. When a holiday falls on a weekday, the collection for that day and all following days of that week will be one day late.
- 15. The possibility of extra charges can be reduced or eliminated by following the above guidelines.
