

ORDINANCE NO. 80-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 60-18, PASSED APRIL 9, 2018 RELATIVE TO THE AWARDING OF A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW COLUMBARIUM WALL AT SPRING GROVE CEMETERY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: Ordinance No. 60-18, passed April 9, 2018, authorized the Mayor to advertise for competitive bids and to award a contract to the successful bidder for the construction of a new 120 Niche Columbarium Wall at Spring Grove Cemetery; and

WHEREAS: After review and discussion with the Landscape Architect from Behnke and Associates, the project estimate should be increased to include a contingency of up to 20% due to the size of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

SEC. 1: That the contract amount authorized in Ordinance No 60-18, passed April 9, 2018, is hereby amended from \$60,000 to \$72,000 for the construction of a new 120 Niche Columbarium Wall at Spring Grove Cemetery.

SEC. 2: That the funds to cover this change, in the amount of \$12,000 are available in Account No. 821-0230-54412.

SEC. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

SEC. 4: That this Ordinance shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason to advertise, bid and award as soon as possible; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
