

## City of Medina Sanitation Rate Increase per Ordinance 88-24

### Residential Rates:

- Monthly rates will increase to \$18 from \$16 effective for bills due after July 1, 2024.
- Monthly rates will increase to \$20 from \$18 effective for bills due after July 1, 2025.

### Commercial Rates:

The monthly rate for containers smaller than four (4) cubic yards will increase to \$7 per cubic yard per week from \$5.50 per cubic yard per week effective for bills due after January 1, 2025.

Note that the City's sanitation rates have NOT increased since 2014. The City's costs have increased substantially in that time, a few examples:

1. Fuel:
  - a. Ten years ago the City spent about \$144,000 per year on fuel for Sanitation trucks.
  - b. In 2022 and 2023 the City spent about \$207,000 per year on fuel for Sanitation trucks.
  - c. This is an increase of 43.75%
2. Personnel:
  - a. In 2013 the City spent \$1,058,699 for Sanitation Collection employees (wages and benefits).
  - b. In 2023 the City spent \$1,566,557 for Sanitation Collection employees (wages and benefits).
  - c. This is an increase of 38.52%
3. Equipment:
  - a. In 2015 the City spent \$172,853 for a 25 yard rear load rubbish truck.
  - b. That exact same truck today is \$247,850.
  - c. This is an increase of 43.39%
