RESOLUTION NO. 21-24

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR AN OHIO DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT (ODOD) BROWNFIELD REMEDIATION PROGRAM – ASSESSMENT GRANT TO COVER THE COST OF ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENTS FOR THE SITE LOCATED AT 426 W. LIBERTY STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: The City of Medina, Ohio, along with the Medina County Port Authority, intends to apply for an Ohio Department of Development Brownfield Remediation Program-Assessment Grant to cover the cost of environmental assessments for the former Yost Sunoco site located at 426 W. Liberty Street and execute any and all documents pertaining to this grant funding; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO:

- SEC. 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for an Ohio Department of Development (ODOD) Brownfield Remediation Program-Assessment Grant to cover the cost of environmental assessment for the site located at 426 W. Liberty Street.
- **SEC. 2:** That if the Grant is awarded to the City, the Mayor is authorized to accept the grant and complete all documentation necessary for the implementation and administration of the grant.
- SEC. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.
- SEC. 4: That this Resolution shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason the application is due to the Medina County Port Authority on January 29, 2024; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
