AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 31.05 AND 31.02 (B)(5) AND (B)(6) OF THE SALARIES AND BENEFITS CODE OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, OHIO RELATIVE TO THE MEDINA MUNICIPAL COURT PROBATION DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: Section 31.05 of the Salaries and Benefits Code of the City of Medina, Ohio presently reads as follows pertaining to the Medina Municipal Court:

SEC. 5: That this Ordinance shall be considered an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason Kevin Ross was hired as a Probation Officer on March 25, 2024; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
