Site Location:

The site is located at the west side of the 200 block of S. Court St.

Project Introduction:

The applicant requests a certificate of appropriateness to modify the second floor rear building wall with a new window and add outdoor decks and stair on the roof of the building rear first floor as well as on the ground behind the building for outdoor dining.

The modifications to the rear of the building's second floor would accommodate outdoor use and escape for the existing second floor residential unit.

City of Medina Design Guidelines

Section 145.07 (b): Additions/new construction. With respect to additions/new construction to existing buildings and all new buildings or structures within Historic Districts, it is generally the interest of the Board that such additions/new construction shall be designed to enhance the character of the Historic District. Consistent with the preface of this Chapter, new buildings and additions should be representative of architectural design and construction of contemporary times.

Staff Comments:

The proposed second floor's rear wall modification as well as the second floor and ground outdoor decks (and associated stairs) do not substantively affect the historic character of the existing building and general district.

The exterior finish materials and composition is simple and complementary with the subject property and will actually be a visual improvement even though only visible from the 'private' portion of the subject site.

Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommends that the Historic Preservation Board grant a Certificate of Appropriateness for the proposed additions and alterations to 221 S. Court St. with the following conditions:

1. Subject to approval of building permits from the City of Medina Building Department.

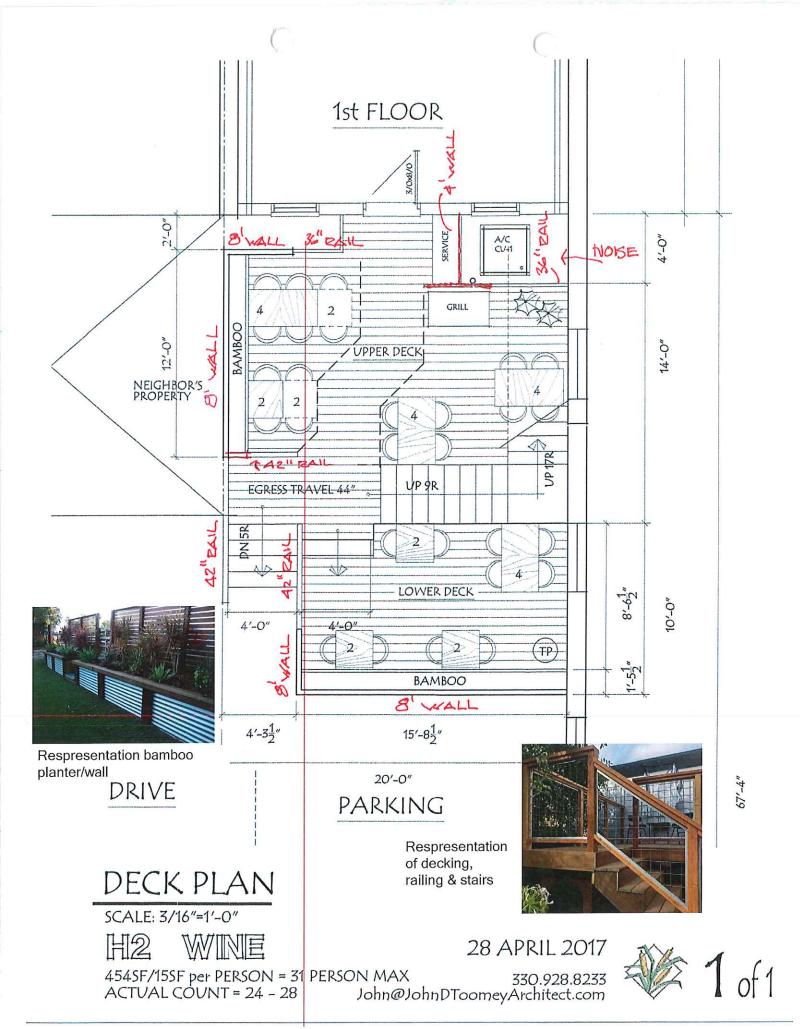


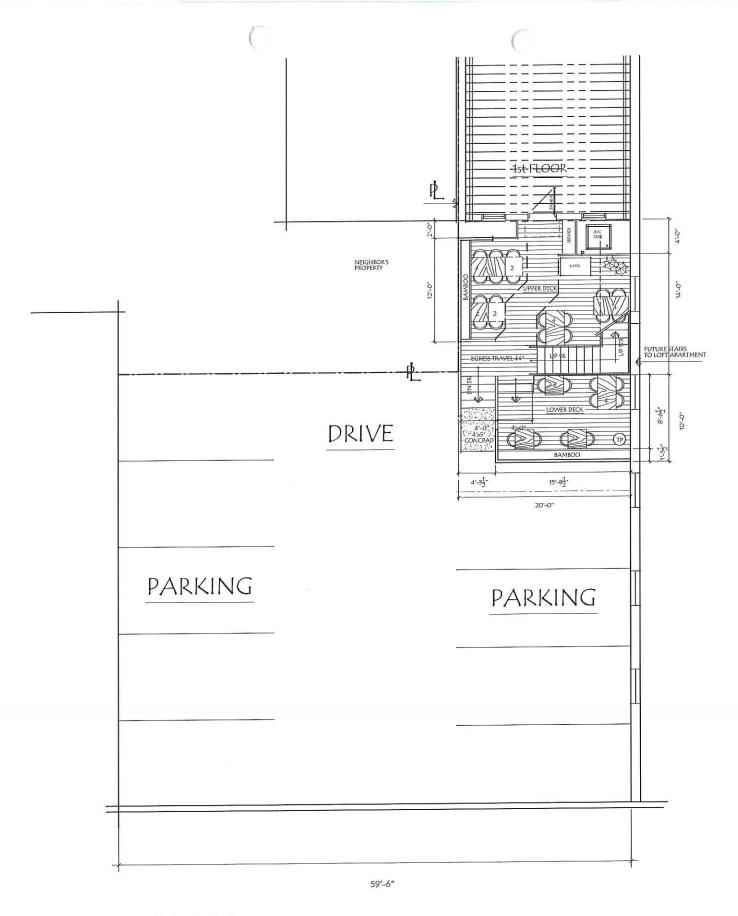

SITE PLAN

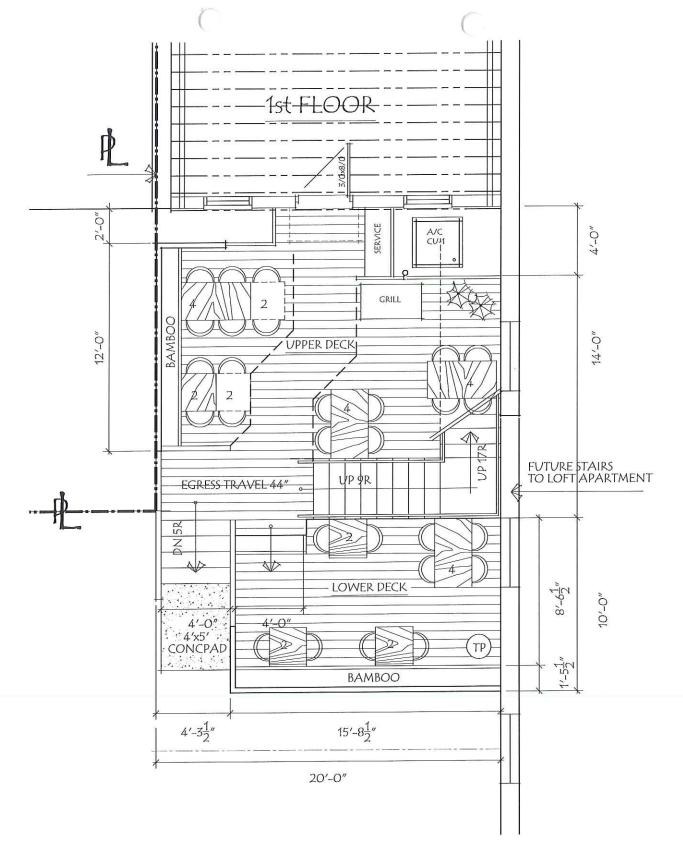

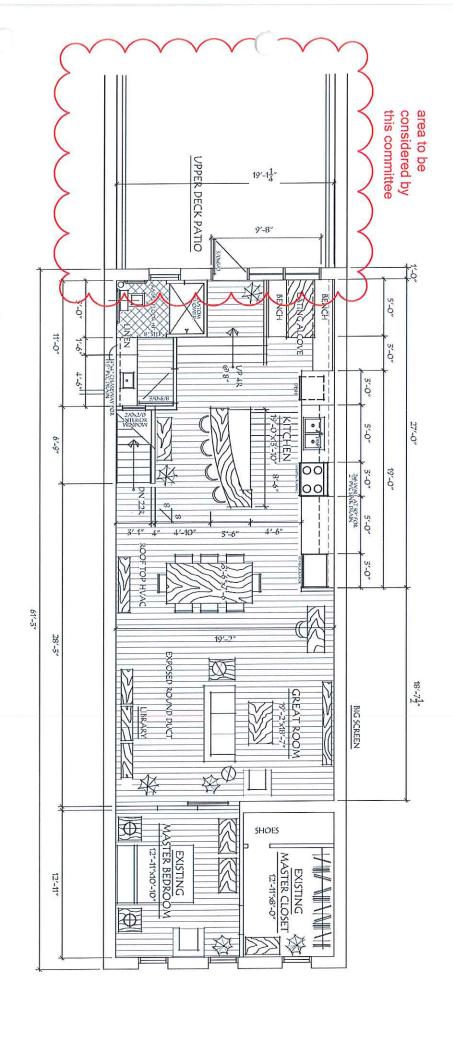

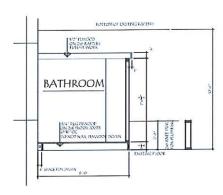
